	Faiccos Pork Store 260 Bleecker St (212) 243-1974 Sicilian Slice Crawl: Ben's, Prince Street,	12:30-1:30PM	We're going to pre order subs at faiccoss and eat at the piers on the west side; stop at these sicilian slice places on the way. At the old-school counter, patrons take a number upon entering the store and step to the counter when called to rattle off their order. Hefty wedges of provolone and grapefruit-sized balls of fresh mozzarella are enough to make regulars of vegetarians.
	Staten Island Ferry 4 SOUTH STREET	6:15 PM	MEET IN FRONT OF HOTEL - Walk left out of Hotel. Left on Bowery, Enter Subway - J - Nassau St Local - Direction: To BROAD STREET. Get off at Broad St. Walk South on Broad until you reach WATER STREET. Turn Right and continue walking (SW direction) until you reach South Ferry 1. Turn Left and continue until you reach Whitehall Terminal. Arrive for the 6:45 Ferry. (Ferry leaves every 15-20 minutes) The Staten Island Ferry provides transportation to 20 million people a year!

Take the S44 Bus towards S44 S I Mall Yukon Ave 7:16pm - 7:42pm (27 mins, 31 stops). Get off at PORT RICHMOND AVE - HOOKER PL. Pass Hooker Pl. and Denino's Pizzeria Tavern will be on the Right. Denino's, established in 1937, is beloved by Staten Islanders. Notice their pizza boxes: "In Crust we Trust!"

	Eataly 200 5th Ave (212) 229-2560	12:00PM	Meet in front of hotel and we'll walk together Piedmontese mega-market Eataly opened by Mario Batali and Joe Bastianich boasts separate restaurants devoted to meat, fish, vegetables, pasta and pizza, and panini — plus a rooftop brewpub. It's like a mall and a food court for anything and everything Italian.
	Shake Shack Madison Square Park	1:30PM	We'll go as a group after Eataly — it's across the street Go late in the afternoon, when the crowds have thinned, sit at one of the regulation-green Parks Department tables, and have one of everything on the menu—perfect, smallish L.A.-style burgers that have no equal in New York; dressed to the nines Chicago-style dogs with authentic Day-Glo-green relish; a purple cow made with Grape Crush from the bottle; and frozen custard that tastes like a dream.

	Italy and the High Line: Cheslea Market (75 9th Ave) , Artichoke Basilles (114 10th Ave)	11:00AM	MEET IN FRONT OF HOTEL and we'll walk as a group to the High Line, by way of the Chelsea Market and Artichoke Basilles. The High Line is a public park built on an historic freight rail line elevated above the streets on Manhattan's West Side. It runs from Gansevoort Street in the Meatpacking District to West 34th Street, between 10th & 11th Avenues. The first section of the High Line opened on June 9, 2009. It runs from Gansevoort Street to West 20th Street. The second section, which runs between West 20th and West 30th Streets, opened June 8, 2011.
	San Gennaro Festival Little Italy	2:00PM-9PM	2 to 3 PM – 12th Annual Cannoli Eating Competition The Performance Stage at the northwest corner of Grand and Mott Streets will be the site of this eating competition, sanctioned by The International Federation of Competitive Eaters, to determine who can eat the most cannoli within a given six-minute period? The winner will be recognized as The World's Champion Cannoli Eater. 6 to 7 PM - Blessing of the Stands Parish Priests from Most Precious Blood Church will walk through the streets of the Feast blessing all the restaurants, cafes, shops and vendors so that they will all have a successful Feast. Presented annually since 1926 by Figli di San Gennaro, Inc. (Children of San Gennaro), a not-for-profit community organization dedicated to keeping alive the spirit and faith of the early Italian immigrants, this year's Feast is expected once again to attract more than one-million people from the four corners of the globe to the streets of Little Italy to participate in the annual Salute to the Patron Saint of Naples. Although this is an annual celebration of faith, the Feast of San Gennaro is known the world over for its festive atmosphere, an 11-day event featuring religious processions and colorful parades, free musical entertainment every day, a wide variety of ethnic food delicacies, charming restaurants and cafes and even a world-famous cannoli-eating competition! The central focus of the celebration takes place every September 19th, the official Saint Day when a celebratory Mass is held in Most Precious Blood Church, followed immediately by a religious procession in which the Statue of San Gennaro is carried from its permanent home in the church through the streets that comprise Little Italy.
	Rubirosa 235 Mulberry Street (Between Prince and Spring) (212) 965-0500	9:30PM	If you aren't already at the San Gennaro festival, MEET IN FRONT OF HOTEL go left out of the hotel, then left on BOWERY, Right on SPRING, walk 3 blocks, take a left on Mulberry and it's on the next block on the right. Rubirosa is Angelo (AJ) Pappalardo's family-run neighborhood Italian-American restaurant and pizzeria. AJ has preserved his family's 53 year old thin-crust pizza recipe. The family recipe originated in 1960 at Joe and Pats pizzeria in Staten Island which is the namesake pizzeria of AJ's father Giuseppe.
